
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The MLS-SCM programme was singled out as a model for sustainable training capacity development in the ITC programme evaluation in 2007. It offers an internationally recognised professional certification programme.

The programme offers three levels of professional recognition as follows:

- International Certificate in supply chain management, awarded after successful completion of the exams for Modules 1-6 (level one).
- Advanced International Certificate in supply chain management, awarded after successful completion of the exams for the above Modules plus Modules 7-12 (level two).
- International Diploma supply chain management, awarded upon completion of all the 12 Modules plus 3 of the supplementary Modules (13-16) & successful completion of the Project report or Module 13-18. This is level three.

Exams are taken in the home country, with the local MLS-SCM network member institution being responsible for handling all local arrangements; in the Ethiopian case BCaD-Consulting Management is in charge. The exams themselves are developed and marked by an international panel of experts consisting of high-level specialists from all continents. Paper-based exams are organised twice a year and online exams (as an option) will become available during June 2010.










Cost and Time?

The cost of the training for institutionally sponsored applicants is \$1000.00 for each level . The fee for individual applicants is \$720.00 for each level and Registration fee \$30.00. N.B. Re-sit on exams is \$50.00 per module. If you prefer to take a specific module, the fee per Module is \$250.00. The start up days are on 15 August and 15 November for year 2010.
